The Parable of the Wedding Feast

Matthew 22:1-7
The Calling

- 1) And having answered, Jesus again spoke to them in parables, saying:
- 2) The kingdom of Heaven has been like to a man being a king, who made a wedding feast for his son.

#### Literal English Translation

- 3) And he sent his slaves to call the ones who had been invited to the wedding feast, and they were not desiring to come.
- 4) Again, he sent other slaves, saying, Tell the ones who had been invited, Behold, I have prepared my dinner; my oxen, and the fatted cattle have been killed, and all things *are* ready; come into the wedding feast.
- 5) But the ones having disregarded *it* went away, the one indeed into *his* own field, and the one into *his* business.
- 6) And the ones remaining, having seized his slaves, they mistreated and killed *them*.
- 7) And when the king heard, he became angry. And having sent his armies, he destroyed those murderers and he burned their city.

Matthew 22:8-10 The Compelling

- 8) Then he says to his slaves, Indeed, the wedding feast is ready, but the ones who had been invited were not worthy.
- 9) Therefore go onto the crossroads of the highways and as many as you might find, call into the wedding feast
- 10) And those slaves having gone out into the highways, gathered all, as many as they found, both evil and good. And the wedding feast was filled *with* reclining guests.

- 11) And when the king had come in to view the ones reclining, he saw there a man not having been dressed in a wedding feast garment.
- 12) And he says to him, Friend, how did you enter here, not having a wedding feast garment? But the man was speechless.
- 13) Then the king said to the servants, Having bound his feet and hands, take him away and throw *him* out into the outermost darkness. There shall be the weeping and the gnashing of the teeth.
- 14) For many are called, but few chosen.
