Isaiah 11:1-5

The Characteristics of the Messiah

1 And there shall come out a sprout from out of the stump of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow fruit from out of its roots:

2 And the spirit of Yahweh shall descend upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and strength, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of Yahweh;

3 And He shall take pleasure in the fear of Yahweh: and he shall not judge according to the sight of his eyes, neither make decisions according to the hearing of his ears:

4 And in righteousness shall he judge the poor, and make decisions with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he kill the wicked.

5 And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his hips.

Isaiah 11:6-9

The Conditions in the Millennium

6 And the wolf shall dwell with the lamb, and the leopard shall lie down with the young goat; and the calf and the young lion and the fattened calf together; and a small child shall lead them.

7 And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together: and the lion shall eat straw like the ox.

8 And the nursing child shall play upon the opening of the asp, and the weaned child shall put his hand upon the den of the viper.

9 They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of Yahweh, as the waters cover the sea.

Isaiah 11:10

The Collection of the Gentiles

10 And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and his resting place shall be glory.

Isaiah 11:11-16

The Collection of the Remnant

11 And it will be in that day, *that* the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the coasts of the sea.

12 And he shall set up an ensign for the Gentiles, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

13 And the envy of Ephraim shall depart, and the enemies of Judah shall be cut off: Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not oppress Ephraim.

14 But they shall fly upon the shoulders of the Philistines toward the west; they shall plunder them of the east together: they shall lay their hand upon Edom and Moab; and the children of Ammon shall obey them.

15 And Yahweh shall completely destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall strike it into the seven streams, and make *men* go over with dry sandals.

16 And there shall be a highway for the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria; like as it was to Israel in the day that it came up from out of the land of Egypt.
