Isaiah 15:1a  
The Caption

1 ¶ The burden of Moab:

Isaiah 15:1b-4  
The Conditions from the Judgment

Because in a night Ar of Moab has been devastated; it has been destroyed; because in a night Kir of Moab has been devastated; it has been destroyed.

2 He will have gone up to *the* house, even to Dibon, *to* the high places, to weep. Moab shall howl over Nebo and over Medeba; on all their heads *shall be* baldness, every beard shaved.

3 In their streets they shall put on sackcloth; upon the tops of their roof tops, and in their streets, everyone shall howl going down in weeping.

4 And Heshbon shall cry, and Elealeh; their voice shall have been heard until Jahaz; therefore armed soldiers of Moab shall quiver; his life shall have quivered for himself.

Isaiah 15:5-9  
The Cry of God over Moab

5 My heart shall cry out for Moab; her refugees to Zoar, a heifer of three years; because the ascent of Luhith in weeping they shall go up on it. because *in* the road of Horonaim they shall raise up a cry of brokenness.

6 ¶ Because the waters of Nimrim shall be devastation; because the grass will have dried up; it will have come to an end; green vegetation will not have grown.

## **Isaiah Chapter 15:1-9**

### **Literal English Translation**

**7 Therefore the storage,  
they have made, and that which they have laid  
up; they shall carry them over the brook of  
the poplars.**

**8 Because the cry has gone around the  
territory of Moab; the howling of it until  
Eglaim; and the howling of it unto Beer- Elim.**

**9 Because the waters of Dimon shall have  
been filled of blood; because I will put *things*  
being added upon Dimon, a lion for the  
fugitives of Moab, and for the remnant of the  
land.**
