Isaiah Chapters 24-27 **The Prophecies of Judgment upon the World**

Isaiah 24 **The Infliction of Judgment upon the Earth**

Isaiah 24:1 **The Caption**

1 Look at Yahweh making the earth empty, and making it desolate, and He will have distorted its surface, and He will have scattered the ones dwelling in it.

Isaiah 24:2-4 **The Coming Judgment**

2 And it shall have been, as the people, so the priest; as the male slave, so his master; as the female slave, so her mistress; as the one buying, so the one selling; as the one lending, so the one borrowing; as the one extending credit, according to whom the one getting credit.

3 The earth shall be completely emptied, and completely plundered; because Yahweh has spoken this word.

4 The earth will have mourned and will have faded away, the world will have languished and it will have withered, the exultant people of the earth will have become feeble.

Isaiah 24:5 **The Cause of the Judgment**

5 And the earth will have been defiled under the ones dwelling in it; because they have passed over laws, they have violated the statutes, they have broken the everlasting covenant.

Isaiah 24:6-13 **The Curse upon the Earth**

6 Upon this a curse has devoured the earth, and the ones dwelling in it are guilty; upon this the ones dwelling on the earth will have burned, and few men have remained.

Isaiah Chapter 24:1-23

Literal English Translation

7 The new wine will have mourned, the vine will have withered, all the hearing of joy will have sighed.

8 The mirth of tambourines will have ceased, the noise of the exultant will have stopped, the joy of the lyre will have ceased.

9 They shall not drink wine with the song; strong drink shall be bitter to the ones drinking it.

10 The town of nothingness will have been broken down; every house will have been shut up from entering.

11 An outcry over wine in the streets; all joy is darkened, the mirth of the earth will have disappeared.

12 In the city it has been left a desolation, and the gate will be beaten down.

13 Because in this way it shall have been in the midst of the earth in the middle of the peoples, there shall have been as the shaking of an olive tree, as the gleaning grapes when the vintage has done.

Isaiah 24:14-16

The Conflict of Isaiah

14 They themselves shall lift up their voices, they shall shout for the majesty of Yahweh, they shall have shouted from the sea.

15 Upon this glorify Yahweh in the east, the name of Yahweh God of Israel in the islands of the sea.

16 From the ends of the earth we have heard songs, glory to the righteous One. But I say, My wasting away, my wasting away, woe to me! the ones acting treacherously have acted treacherously; the ones acting treacherously have acted very treacherously.

Isaiah 24:17-23

The Consequences of the Judgment

17 Fear, and a pit, and a trap, *are* upon you, The ones dwelling of the earth.

Isaiah Chapter 24:1-23

Literal English Translation

18 And it shall have been, the one fleeing from the noise of the terror shall fall into the pit; and the one rising up from the middle of the pit shall be caught in the trap; because the windows of the heavens will have opened, and the foundations of the earth will shake.

19 The earth has completely broken down, the earth shall have been shaken to and fro completely, the earth will have been completely tottering.

20 The earth shall completely stagger as the drunkard, and shall have swayed as the hut; and its rebellion shall have been heavy upon it; and it shall have fallen, and will not again rise.

21 And it shall have been in that day, Yahweh shall intervene concerning the host of the heavens in the heavens, and concerning the kings of the earth upon the earth.

22 And they shall have gathered together, an imprisonment of prisoners in a pit, and shall have been shut up in a prison, and after many days shall they be punished.

23 And the full moon shall have been ashamed, and the sun shall have been ashamed, because Yahweh of Hosts shall have reigned in Mount Zion, and in Jerusalem, and before *the* glory of his elders.
