Isaiah 25

The Inspired Song of Isaiah

Isaiah 25:1-5
The Chorus of the Celebration of Israel.

1 ¶ Yahweh, You *are* my God. I will exalt You; I will praise Your name; because You have done *a* wonder: counsels from long ago, perfect faithfulness.

2 Because You have made from *a* city to *a* heap of stones, a fortified city into a ruin; a palace of foreigners from *being* a city, it will not be built for eternity.

3 Therefore *a* people of strength will glorify You, *a* city of the violent nations shall reverence You.

4 Because You have been *a* stronghold to the poor, a stronghold to the needy in his distress, a refuge from storm, *a* shade from heat; when *the* wind of the violent *is* as *a* storm *against* a wall.

5 You shall bring down the uproar of foreigners, as heat in *a* dry place, *as* heat in the shade of *a* cloud; *so* the song of the violent *ones* shall be brought low.

Isaiah 25:6-8
The Coronation Feast of Yahweh

6 ¶ And Yahweh of Hosts shall have made *a* feast of fat things for all the people in this mountain; *a* feast of wines on the lees, of fat things full of marrow, wines on the lees being filtered.

Isaiah Chapter 25:1-12

Literal English Translation

7 And He will swallow up in this mountain the surfaces of the covering covering over all people, and the veil that is spread over all nations.

8 He will have swallowed up death forever! And the Lord Yahweh will have wiped away tears from upon all faces. And He shall have removed the reproach of His people from upon all the earth; because Yahweh has spoken.

Isaiah 25:9-12
The Chorus of Deliverance and Destruction

9 ¶ And it shall have been said in that day, Look, this *is* our God; we have waited for Him, and He will save us. This *is* Yahweh; we have waited for Him; let us be glad and let us rejoice in His salvation.

10 Because the hand of Yahweh shall settle in this mountain; and Moab shall have been trampled down under him, as a pile of straw *is* trampled down in a dunghill.

11 And He shall have spread His hands in the middle of them, as the one swimming shall spread out *his hands* to swim. And He shall have brought down his pride together with *the* trickery of His hands.

12 And He shall have brought down the fortress of the high places of your walls; He will have brought down, have brought to the ground, (even) to dust.
