**1 The wilderness and the dry place will be glad. And the desert shall rejoice and blossom as a rose.**

**2 It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice also abundantly and shouting for joy. The glory of Lebanon shall have been given to it, the majesty of Carmel and Sharon, they themselves shall see *the* glory of Yahweh, *even* the majesty of our God.**

The Restoration of the People

**3 Make strong *the* weak hands, and make steady *the* knees being feeble.**

**4 Say to the ones being anxious of heart, "Be strong. Do not be afraid. Behold, your God will come *with* vengeance, *even* the recompense of God. He Himself will come and He will save you."**

**5 Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.**

**9 A lion shall not be there, and *any* ravenous beasts shall not go up upon it. It shall not be found there; but the ones being redeemed shall have been walking *in it*.**

**10 The ones who have been ransomed of Yahweh shall return, and they shall have come to Zion in shouting; and everlasting rejoicing upon their heads. They shall obtain rejoicing and gladness, and grief and sighing shall have fled away.”**

#### Hebrews 12:1-4

##### The Course of God for Every Believer

1 For indeed therefore we being also surrounded with having so great *a* cloud of witnesses, after having laid aside every weight and the sin easily surrounding us, we should run through endurance the race being set before us,

2 while looking off toward Jesus the Author and Finisher of the faith, who over against the joy being set before Him, He endured *the* cross, having despised the shame, and sat down in *the* right of the throne of God.

3 For analyze the One who had endured such opposition by sinners toward Himself, in order that you should not grow weary, *by* fainting in you minds.

4 ¶ You did not yet resist until shedding of blood, while striving against sin.

#### Hebrews 12:5-11

##### The Chastisement of God for Every Believer

5 And you have forgotten the encouragement which speaks to you, as with sons, “My son, do not despise the discipline of *the* Lord, nor be faint *while* being corrected by Him.

6 For whom *the* Lord is loving, He is disciplining, and is scourging every son whom He is receiving.

## Hebrews 12:1-13

### Literal English Translation

**7** If you are enduring discipline, God is dealing *with* you as *with* sons; for what son is *he* whom *a* father is not disciplining?

**8** But if you are without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate, and not sons.

**9** then, indeed we were having fathers of our flesh *as* correctors, and we were giving *them* respect. Shall we not much rather be subjected to the Father of spirits, and we shall live?

**10** For the ones, on the one hand, were disciplining *us* for *a* few days according that which was seeming good to them, but, on the other hand, He for *our* profit, for us to be partakers of His holiness.

**11** And all discipline being for the present, on the one hand, does not seem to be of joy, but of grief; but, on the other hand, afterward it is yielding *the* peaceable fruit of righteousness to the ones who have been exercised through it.

**12** On account of which lift up the hands having been wearied and the knees having become feeble;

**13** and make straight paths for your feet, in order that the lame should not be turned aside, but it rather may be healed.
