The Certification of the Promise of Remption

**1 ¶ But now this way has said Yahweh
the One creating you, O Jacob;
and *the One* forming you, O Israel:**

**Fear not, because I have redeemed you;
I have called *you* in your name;
you are for Me.**

The Reassurance

**2 When you pass over in the waters,
I *will be* with you;
and in the rivers,
they shall not sweep you away.**

**When you will walk in *the* fire,
you shall not be burned,
and the flame shall not set fire on you.**

Isaiah 43:3-4

The Ransom

**3 Because I *am* Yahweh your God,
the Holy One of Israel, your Savior.**

**I have given Egypt *for* your ransom;
Ethiopia and Seba in place of you.**

**4 Because you have been precious in My eyes,
you have been honored,
and I have loved you,
and I will give men in place of you;
and people on behalf of your life.**

**9 All the nations will have been gathered together,
and let *the* people be assembled.**

**Who among will cause this to be declared
and cause us to hear former things?**

**Let them bring their witnesses,
and let them be justified;
and let them hear and let them
say, True!**

Isaiah 43:10-13

The Confirmation of Yahweh from Redeemed Israel

**10 You *are* My witnesses,
a declaration of Yahweh;**

**and My servant whom I have elected;
so that you will know
and you will be caused to believe Me,
and you will understand that I *am* He.**

**Before Me there has not been *a* god formed;
and there shall not be *one* after Me.**

**11 I, I *am* Yahweh;
and apart from Me *there is* none saving.**

**12 I have caused to be declared,
and I have caused to be saved,
and I have caused to be heard;**

**and *there is* not *a* foreign *god* among you.
And you *are* My witnesses,
a declaration of Yahweh,
and I *am* God.**

**13 Also from *the first* day I *am* He,
and *there is* none causing deliverance from My hand.
I will act, and who will cause it to be turned back?**

The Captives Delivered

14 ¶ This way has said Yahweh, your Redeemer, *the* Holy One of Israel:

For your sake I will have sent to Babylon, and I will have brought down all of their fugitives, and *the* Chaldeans, their rejoicing *is* in the ships.

15 I *am* Yahweh, your Holy One, the One creating Israel, your King.

Isaiah 43:16-17

The Contemplation on the Past
Deliverance

16 This way has said Yahweh, the One making *a* way in the sea, and *a* path in mighty waters;

17 The One causing to go out *the* chariot and horse, *an* army and power. They shall lie down together; they shall not rise; they had been extinguished; they had been quenched as the wick.

Isaiah 43:18-19

The Consideration of the Future
Deliverance

18 Do not remember *the* former things, and do not consider the things of old.

**19 Behold, I am doing *a* new thing; now it shall spring up. Shall you not know it?
I will indeed make *a* way in the wilderness, rivers in *the* desert.**

Isaiah 43:20-21

The Celebration of Yahweh

20 The beast of the field shall honor Me, *the* jackals and *the* daughters of *the* ostrich, because I will have given waters in the wilderness, rivers in *the* desert, to give drink to My people, My elect.

21 This people I have formed for Myself they shall proclaim My praise.

Isaiah 43:22-25

The Condition of Israel

22 ¶ But you have not called to Me, Jacob; but you have been weary with Me, Israel.

23 You have not brought to Me the sheep of your burnt offerings; and you have not honored Me with your sacrifices. I have not caused you to serve with *a* grain offering, and I have not wearied you with incense.

Isaiah 43:1-28

Literal English Translation

**24 You have not bought to Me
spice cane with silver, and you
have not filled Me *with the* fat of
your sacrifices; indeed you have
caused Me to serve with your sins;
you have wearied Me with your
iniquities.**

**25 I, I, *am* He the One blotting out
your transgressions for My sake;
and I will not remember your sins.**

Isaiah 43:26-28

The Challenge to Israel

**26 Cause Me to remember; let us
litigate together; declare yourself,
so that you may be justified.**

**27 Your first father had sinned,
and your spokesmen have rebelled
against Me.**

**28 And I will defile the officials of
the Holy Place, and I will have
given Jacob to the curse,
and Israel to revilings.**
