Isaiah 45:1-4

The Commission of God Concerning Cyrus

1) **This way has said Yahweh
to His anointed,
to Cyrus,
whom I have strengthened
in his right hand,

to tread down before him *the* nations.**

**And I will loosen the loins of kings,
to open doors before him,
and the gates will not be shut.**

2) **I Myself will walk before you
and high places I will make level;**

**I will break in pieces the doors of bronze,
and I will cut away the bars of iron.**

3) **And I will have given you the treasures
of darkness, and hidden treasures in secret places,**

**so that you will know that I *am* Yahweh,
the One calling in your name,
the God of Israel.**

Except Me,
there is no God.

I will equip you,
and you will not have known Me,

6) so that they will know
from the rising of the sun,
and from the setting of it,
that *there is* no one, except Me.

I *am* Yaweh,
and *there is* none other.

7) the One forming light,
and creating darkness;
the One making peace,
and creating evil.

I *am* Yahweh,
the One doing all these things.

9) **Woe to the one contending
with the One Forming him.**

**A potsherd
with *the* potsherds of the ground!**

**Will clay say to *the One* forming it,
"What are you making?"**

**and does your work say,
"*There are no hands to him?*"**

10) **Woe to the one saying to a father,
"What are you causing to be fathered?"
And to a woman,
"What are you having labor pains over?"**

**12) I Myself have made *the* earth,
and man I have created upon it.**

**I Myself, My hands
have stretched out the heavens;**

and I have commanded all their host.

**13) I Myself
have awakened him in righteousness,**

and all his ways I will make level.

**He himself will build My city,
and My captives he will set free;
not for *a* price,
and not for *a* gift,**

Isaiah 45:14-15

The Content of the Promises

**14) In this way has said Yahweh,
The labor of Egypt,
and the merchandise of Ethiopia,
and of the Sabeans, men of stature,**

**shall pass over to you;
and they shall be for you.**

**They shall come behind you;
and they shall pass over to you in chains;
and they shall bow down to you;**

they shall petition to you.

**'Certainly God *is* among you,
and *there is* none other;
there is none after God.**

**15) Truly, You *are* a God hiding Himself,
The God of Israel,
the Savior.**

Isaiah 45:16-17

The Contrast in the Promises

**16) They shall have become ashamed,
and also they shall have become disgraced,
all of them.**

**Together they shall have gone in disgrace,
the craftsmen of idols.**

**17) Israel will have been saved in Yahweh
a salvation of eternity.**

**You shall not be ashamed
and you shall not be disgraced
until eternity of everlasting.**

The Provision of God concerning Salvation

Isaiah 45:18-19

The Confidence of the Provision

18) Because in this way has said Yahweh,
the One creating the heavens;
He is the God,
the One forming the earth
and making it;

He has established it,
not creating it empty,
but forming it for inhabiting.

I am Yahweh,
and *there is* none other.

19) I have not spoken in secret,
in a place of darkness of the earth.

I have not said to *the* seed of Jacob,
Seek Me *in* emptiness.

I Yahweh
the One speaking righteousness,
the One declaring uprightness.

Isaiah 45:20-22

The Call to the Provision

20) Assemble yourselves
and come;
draw near together,
survivors of the nations;

they have not known
the ones carrying the wood
of their idols,
and *the ones* praying to a god
who will not save.

Isaiah 45:1-25

Literal English Translation

21) **Declare**
and come near;

indeed, let them consult together.
Who has heard this from antiquity;
***who* has declared it from then?**

Was *it* not I, Yahweh?
And there *is* none other God,
except Me,
a righteous God
and *a* Savior;

***there is* none except Me.**

22) **Turn to Me**
and be saved,
all *the* ends of the earth;

because I *am* God,
and there *is* none other.

Isaiah 45:23-25

The Confession for the Provision

23) **In Myself I have sworn *an* oath,**
a Word has gone out from My mouth
***in* righteousness,**
and it shall not return,

that to Me every knee shall have bowed,
every tongue shall swear *an* oath.

24) **He shall have said,**
Only in Yahweh
***is* to Me righteousness and strength;**
to Him he will come;
and they will be ashamed,

all the ones being angry with Him.

25) **In Yahweh**
they shall be righteous,
and they shall glory
all of the seed of Israel
