#### **Isaiah 62:1-9**

**The Promises of God to His People**

Isaiah 62:1-5

The Confirmation of the Future Restoration of Jerusalem

- 1)           **On account of Zion,  
I will not be silent;  
              and on account of Jerusalem,  
I will not be quiet;  
  
              until her righteousness  
                  will go out as the brightness  
              and her salvation  
                  as a torch will burn.**

## **Isaiah 62:1-12**

### Literal English Translation

2) **And nations will have seen  
your righteousness,  
and all of *the* kings  
your glory.**

**And it will be called to you *a* new name  
which *the* mouth of Yahweh  
will designate.**

3) **And you will have been *a* crown of beauty  
in *the* hand of Yahweh,  
and *a* diadem of royalty  
in *the* palm of your God.**

4) **It will not be said to you any longer,**

**Forsaken;**

**and to your land it will not be said  
any more,**

**Desolate.**

**Because to you it will be called,**

**Cephzi -bah;**

**and to your land,**

**Beulah.**

**Because Yahweh**

**will have taken pleasure in you,**

**and your land will be married.**

5) **Because *as a* young man will marry *a* virgin,  
your sons will marry you.**

**And *as the* rejoicing of *a* bridegroom over *a* bride,  
your God will rejoice over you.**

## **Isaiah 62:1-12**

### Literal English Translation

Isaiah 62:6-7

#### The Commission of the Watchmen

- 6) **Upon your walls, O Jerusalem,  
I will have appointed watchmen.**

**All of the day and all of the night  
continually they will not be silent;**

**the ones causing remembrance of Yahweh,  
let there not be rest for you.**

- 7) **And you will not give rest to Him  
until He will establish  
and until He will set up Jerusalem  
a praise in *the* earth.**

Isaiah 62:8-9

#### The Confession of the Oath of Yahweh

- 8) **Yahweh has sworn in His right hand,  
and in the arm of His strength:**

**I certainly will not give your grain any longer  
*as* food to your enemies;  
and certainly *the* sons of *a* foreigner will not drink  
your new wine which you have labored in it.**

- 9) **Because *the ones* gathering it will eat it  
and they will have praised Yahweh.  
And *the ones* collecting it  
will drink it in the courts of My Holy Place.**

## **Isaiah 62:10-12**

### **The Proclamation made to the Nations**

Isaiah 62:10

#### The Commands for God's People

- 10) **Pass through! Pass through in *the* gates;  
make clear *a* way of the people!  
Build up! Build up the highway;  
throw stones from *the* stony place;  
raise up *a* banner over the peoples.**

## **Isaiah 62:1-12**

### Literal English Translation

Isaiah 62:11

#### The Coming of the Savior

**11) Behold, Yahweh has caused *it* to be heard  
to *the* end of the earth;  
Say to *the* daughter of Zion,  
Behold! Your Savior *is* coming!  
Behold! His reward *is* with Him,  
and His recompense *is* before Him.**

Isaiah 62:12

#### The Calling of the New Names

**12) And they will have called to them,  
  
People of Holiness,  
  
Redeemed of Yahweh.  
  
And to you it will be called,  
  
Seeking Out,  
  
A City Not having been Forsaken.**
