and all the crowd had been standing upon the shore.**

The Concealing of the Mysteries

(11) And when *He* answered He said to them,
Because to you it has been given
to know the mysteries of the kingdom
of the heavens,
but to those it has not been given.

(12) For whoever has, it will be given to him
and he will abound;
but whoever does not have, even what he has,
it will be taken away from him.

(13) On account of this I speak to them in parables,
because while seeing they do not see;
and while hearing they do not hear,
neither do they understand.

(14) And upon them is being fulfilled the prophecy of
Isaiah, the one saying *In* hearing you will hear, and you
should never understand; and while seeing you will see,
and should never perceive.

(15) For the heart of this people became fat,
and *with* their ears they heard heavily,
and *with* their eyes they closed;
that they should not see *with* the eyes
and *with* the ears they should hear,
and *with* the heart they should understand,
and they should turn, and I should heal them.

The Clarification of the First Soil

(19) While anyone hearing the Word of the kingdom, and not understanding, the evil one comes, and takes away that which has been sown in his heart. This is the seed sown alongside the road.

The Clarification of the Second Soil

(20) But the seed which had been sown upon rocky places, this is the one hearing the word, and immediately with joy receiving it;

(21) but he does not have root in himself, but it is temporary; and when tribulation or persecution happens on account of the word, immediately he is being offended

The Clarification of the Third Soil

(22) and the seed which has been sown into the thorns, this is the one hearing the word, and the care of this age, and the deception of wealth, chokes the word, and he becomes unfruitful.

(23) But the seed which has been sown upon the good ground this is the one hearing the word, and understanding it; who indeed bears fruit, and produces some a hundred times, and some sixty, and some thirty.
