Literal English Translation

¹ We then that are strong are indebted to bear the infirmities of the weak, and not to please ourselves.

² Let each of us please *his* neighbor for the good to development.

³ For even Christ pleased not himself; but, as it has been written, The insults of the ones insulting you fell upon me.

⁴ For whatever things were written before were written for our teaching, in order that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have hope.

⁵ Now may the God of patience and encouragement give you to think the same thing among one another according as Christ Jesus:

⁶ In order that you might *with* together in one mouth glorify God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

⁷ On account of which, receive one another according as Christ also received us, for *the* glory of God.

⁸ Now I say, Jesus Christ has become a minister of *the* circumcision on behalf of *the* truth of God, for to establish the promises given to the fathers,

⁹ and that the Gentiles might glorify God on behalf of *His* mercy according as it has been written, "On account of this I will confess to You among *the* Gentiles, and I will make music to Your name."

¹⁰ And again He says, "Celebrate, you Gentiles, with His people."

¹¹ And again, "Praise the Lord, all the Gentiles, and praise Him all the people."

¹² And again Isaiah says, "*There* shall be the Root of Jesse, and the One rising to rule over *the* Gentiles; upon Him shall *the* Gentiles hope."

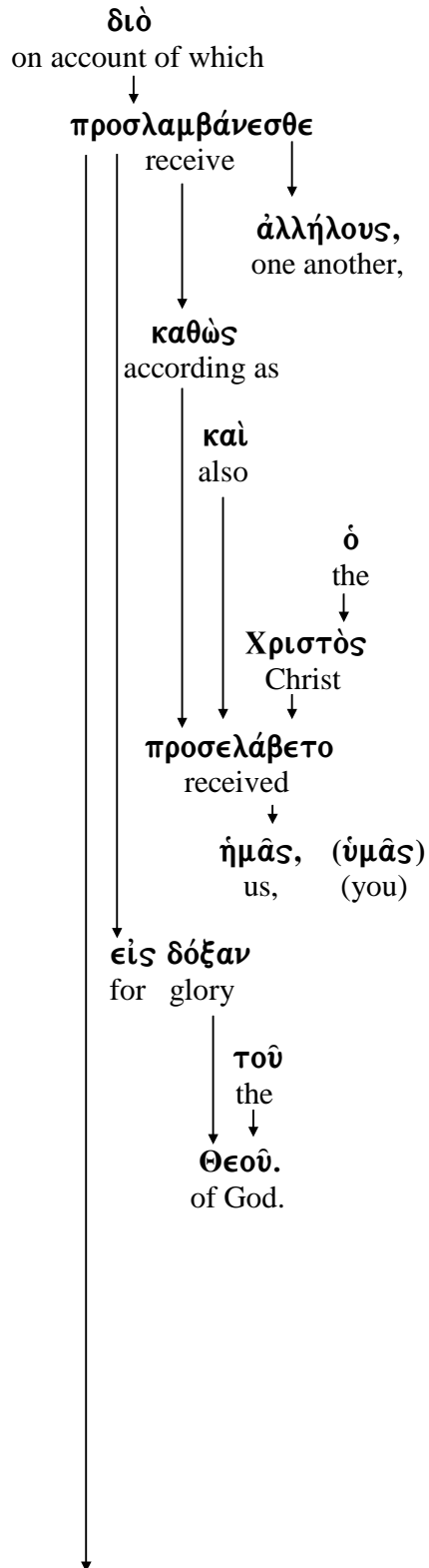

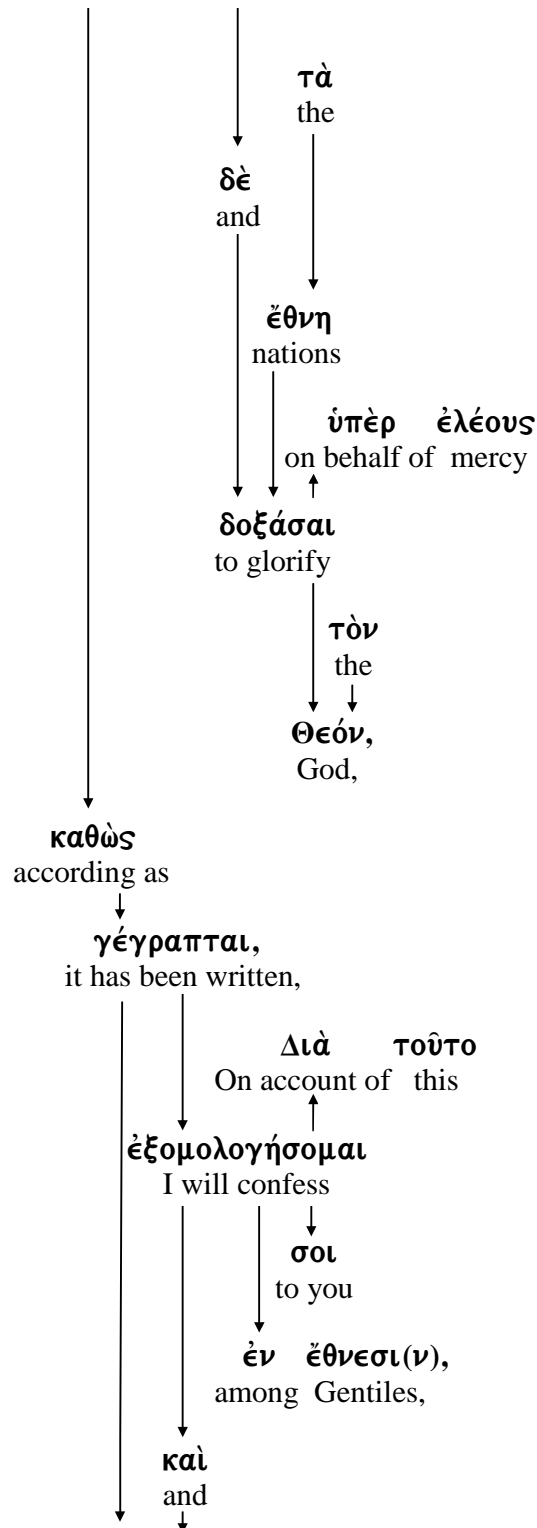

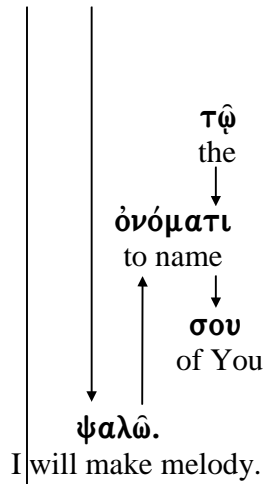

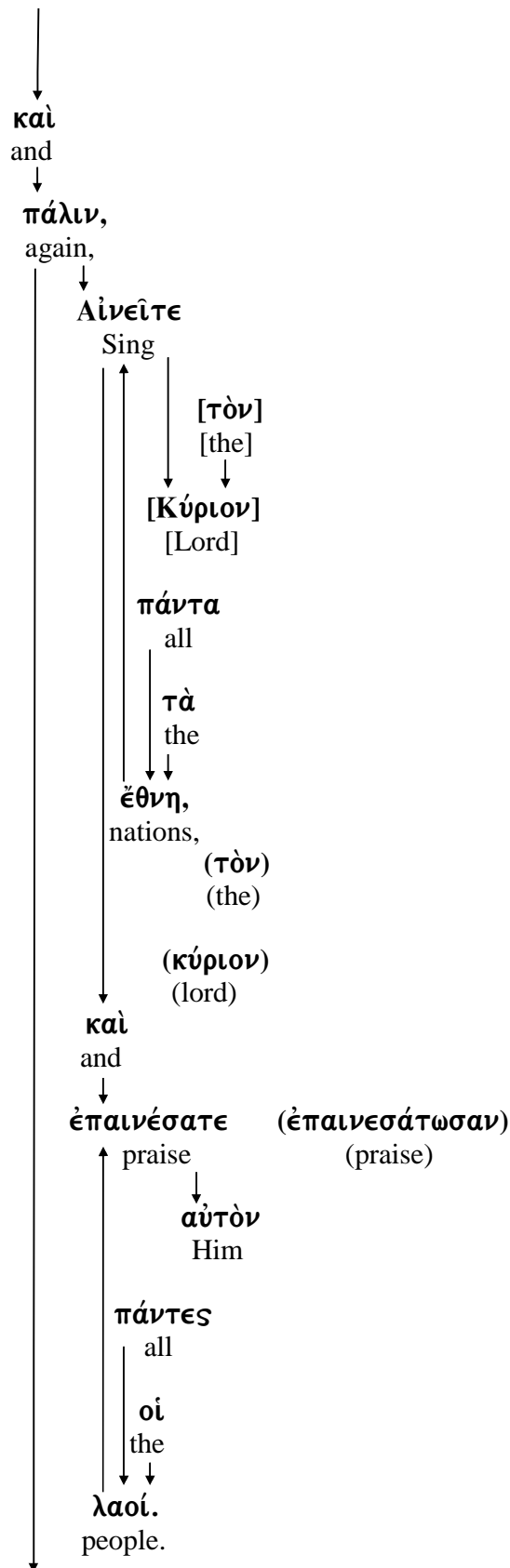

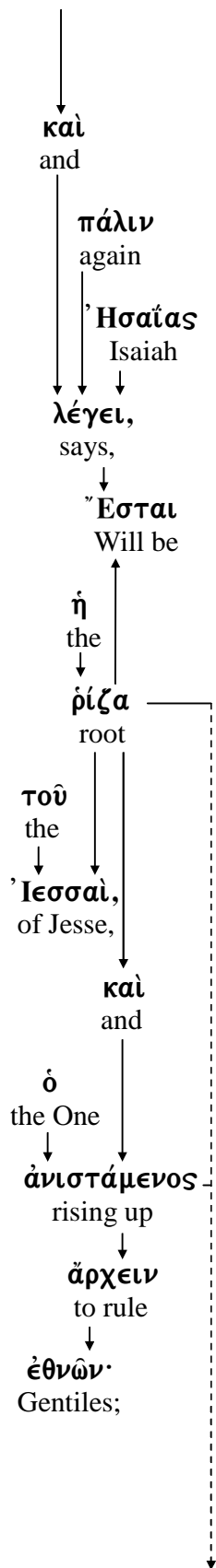
