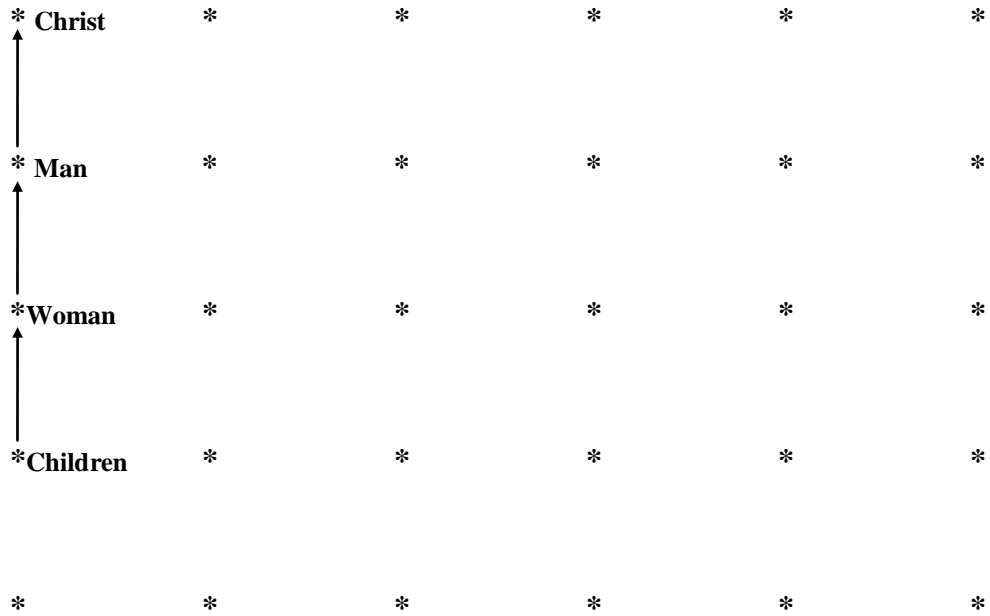

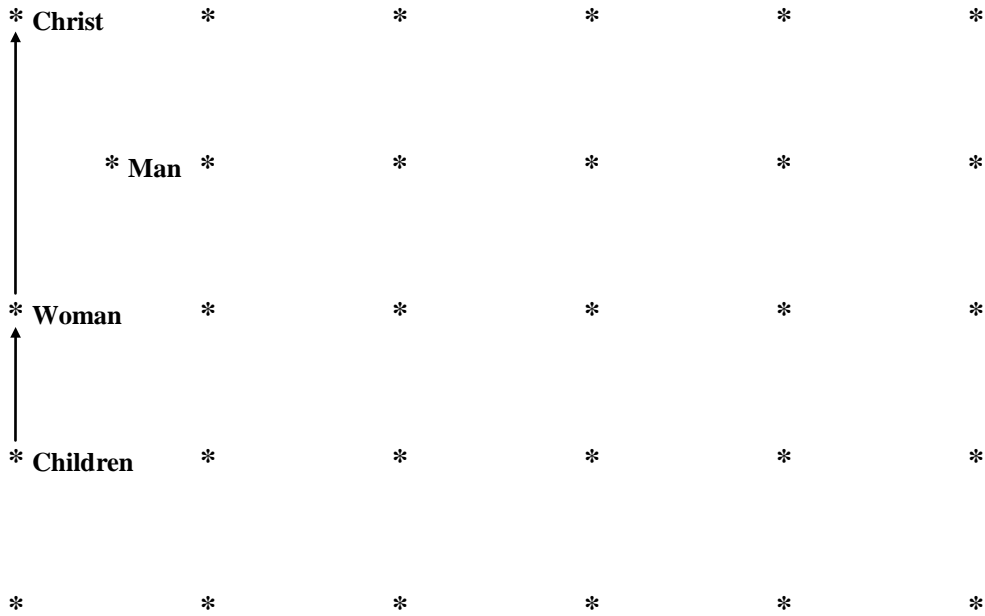

Submission Chart #1: Believer to Believer



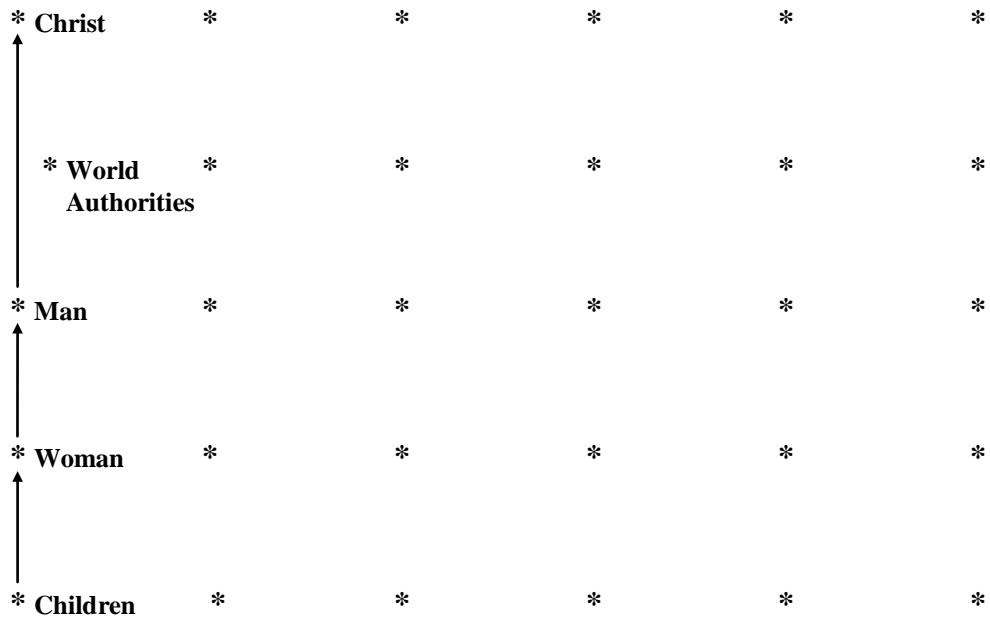
