## **I Peter 5:1-7**

### **Literal Translation**

**1 ¶ I appeal to the elders among you, the one who is a fellow-elder and witness of the sufferings of Christ, the partaker of the glory being about to be revealed:**

**2 Shepherd the flock of God among you, by overseeing, not by necessity, but willingly, neither for base gain, but readily;**

**3 nor as lording over the allotment, but by becoming examples of the flock.**

**4 And when Chief Shepherd has appeared, you will receive the unfading crown of glory.**

**5 ¶ Likewise, younger men be subjected to *the* elders; and everyone by being submissive to one another, be clothed in humble-mindedness, because God resists proud *ones*, but He gives grace to humble ones.**

**6 Therefore, be humbled under the mighty hand of God, in order that He might exalt you in season;**

**7 by having cast all your anxiety upon Him, because it is a care to Him concerning you.**
