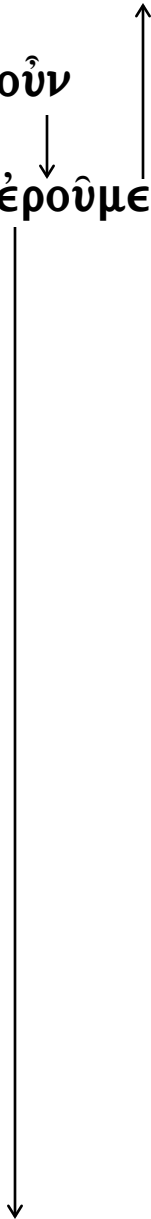

Everyone practicing the sin, also is doing

⁹Everyone who has been born from out of God
πᾶς ὁ γεγεννημένος ἐκ τοῦ θεοῦ

is not practicing sin, because His seed is abiding in Him;
