My spirit is saved but my flesh is not.

12) Therefore then, brothers, we are not debtors to the flesh, to live according to flesh

13) For if you are living according to flesh, you are about to die; but if by the spirit you are putting to death the practices of the body, you will live.

14) For as many as are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

15) For you did not receive a spirit of slavery again for fear, but you received a Spirit of adoption in which we are crying, Abba, Father.

Because the Spirit of Christ lives in me, His Spirit testifies with my Spirit that I belong to Him.

Deuteronomy 19:15

One witness shall not rise up against a man for any transgression, or for any sin, in any sin which he sins. At the mouth of two witnesses or at the mouth of three witnesses a matter shall be established.

Matthew 18:16

But if he should not hear, take one or two more with you, in order that upon the mouth of two or three witnesses every word might stand.

**My salvation relationship began when I was born again,
or regenerated, by the Holy Spirit.**

John 3:3

Jesus answered and said unto him, Truly, Truly, I say to you, If anyone should not be born again, he is not able see the kingdom of God.

Titus 3:5

Not from out of works in righteousness which did, but according to his mercy he saved us, through washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Spirit;

**My spirit became one, or united, with the Spirit of Christ
at Regeneration.**

I John 3:24

And the one keeping His commandments is remaining in Him, and He in him. And in this we are knowing that He is remaining in us, out of the Spirit which He gave to us.

I John 4:13

In this we are knowing that we are remaining in Him, and He in us, because out of His Spirit He has given to us.

**When I became united with His Spirit,
His Spirit also sealed me.**

Ephesians 1:13-14

13) In whom also you, after having heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after having believed, you were sealed *with* the holy Spirit of promise,

14) Who is *the* guarantee of our inheritance for redemption of the purchased possession, for *the* praise of his glory.

Ephesians 4:30

And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, in Whom you were sealed for *the* day of redemption.

This relationship with bear the fruit of God's Spirit.

Matthew 7:15-20

15) But beware from the false prophets who are coming to you in clothing of sheep, but inside they are ravenous wolves.

16) From their fruits you shall know them. Do they gather grapes from thorns, or figs from thorny plants?

17) in this way every good tree is producing good fruits, but the corrupt tree is producing evil fruits.

18) A good tree is not able to produce evil fruits, nor *a* corrupt tree *able* to produce good fruits.

19) Every tree not producing good fruit is being cut down and is being thrown into fire.

20) Certainly from out of their fruits you shall know them.

Galatians 5:22-23

22) Now the fruit of the Spirit is: Agape, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faith,

23) meekness, self-control. Against such things there is no law.

John 15:5

I am the Vine; you *are* the branches. The *one* abiding in Me, and I in him, this one is bearing much fruit, because without Me you are not able to produce one thing.

Assurance and Confirmation

II Corinthians 15:5

Examine yourselves, if you are in the faith; prove yourselves.
Or do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you,
if not you are disqualified?

Colossians 1:27

to whom God willed to make known what *is* the wealth of the glory of this mystery among the nations, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory;

Romans 8:9

Now you yourselves are not in *the* flesh, but in *the* Spirit, if indeed *the* Spirit of God is dwelling in you. And if anyone does not have *the* Spirit of Christ, this one is not of Him.

Romans 8:14

For as many as are being led by *the* Spirit of God,
these are sons of God.

These facts are important - Satan condemns us because of our struggle with the flesh.

Romans 8:1

Therefore then, *there is* no condemnation to the *ones* in Christ Jesus, [not walking according to flesh, but according to Spirit.]

**We struggle with the sin problem,
not with the sin principle.**


