It's purpose: Not meant to produce life but to make sin known

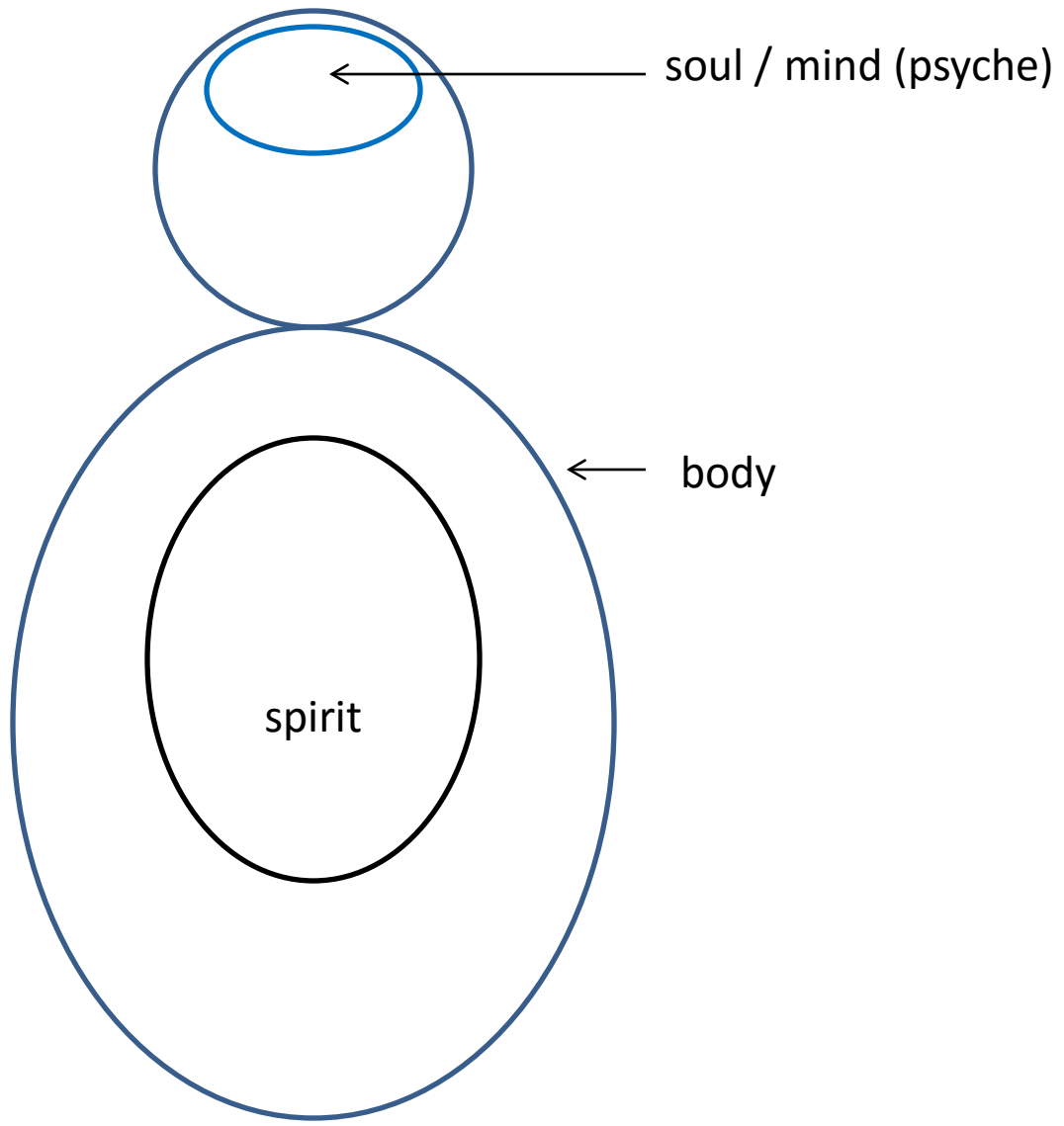

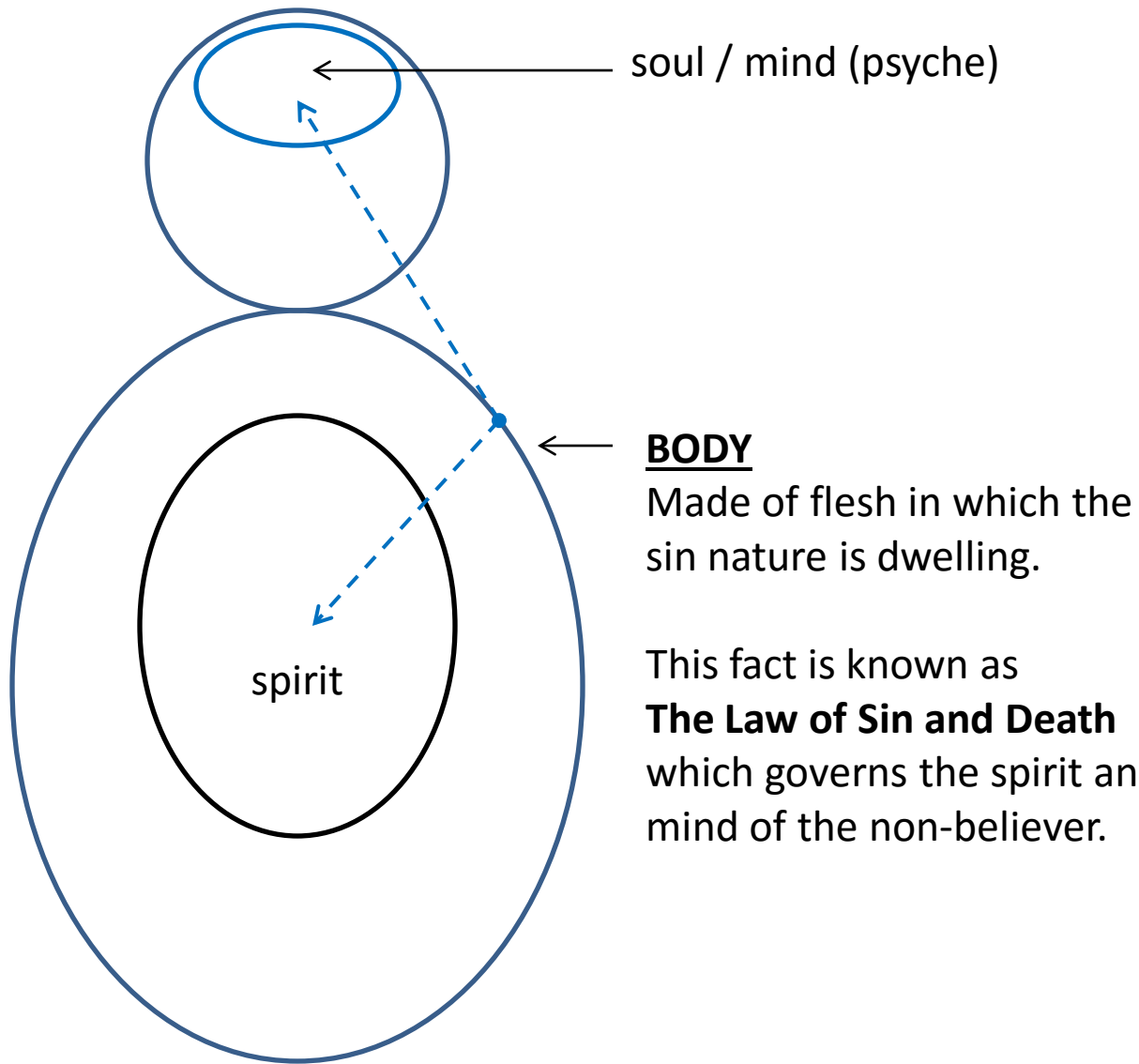
Romans 8:1-39 The Law of the Spirit of the Life in Christ Jesus



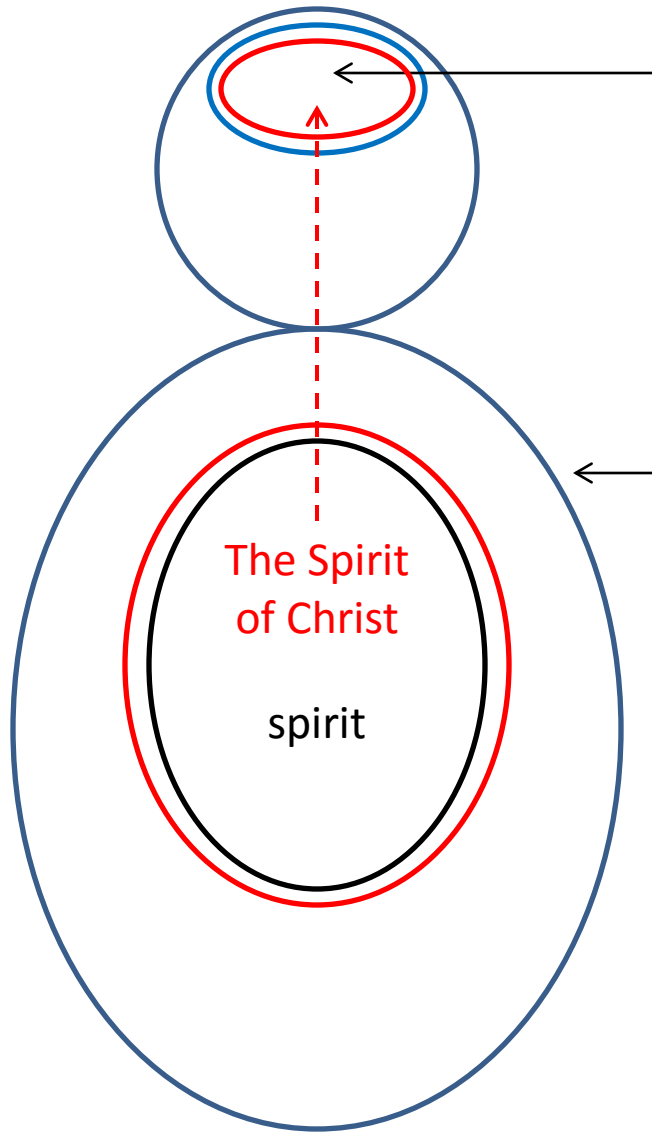
soul / mind (psyche)

When the Spirit of Christ comes into my spirit, I am now governed by

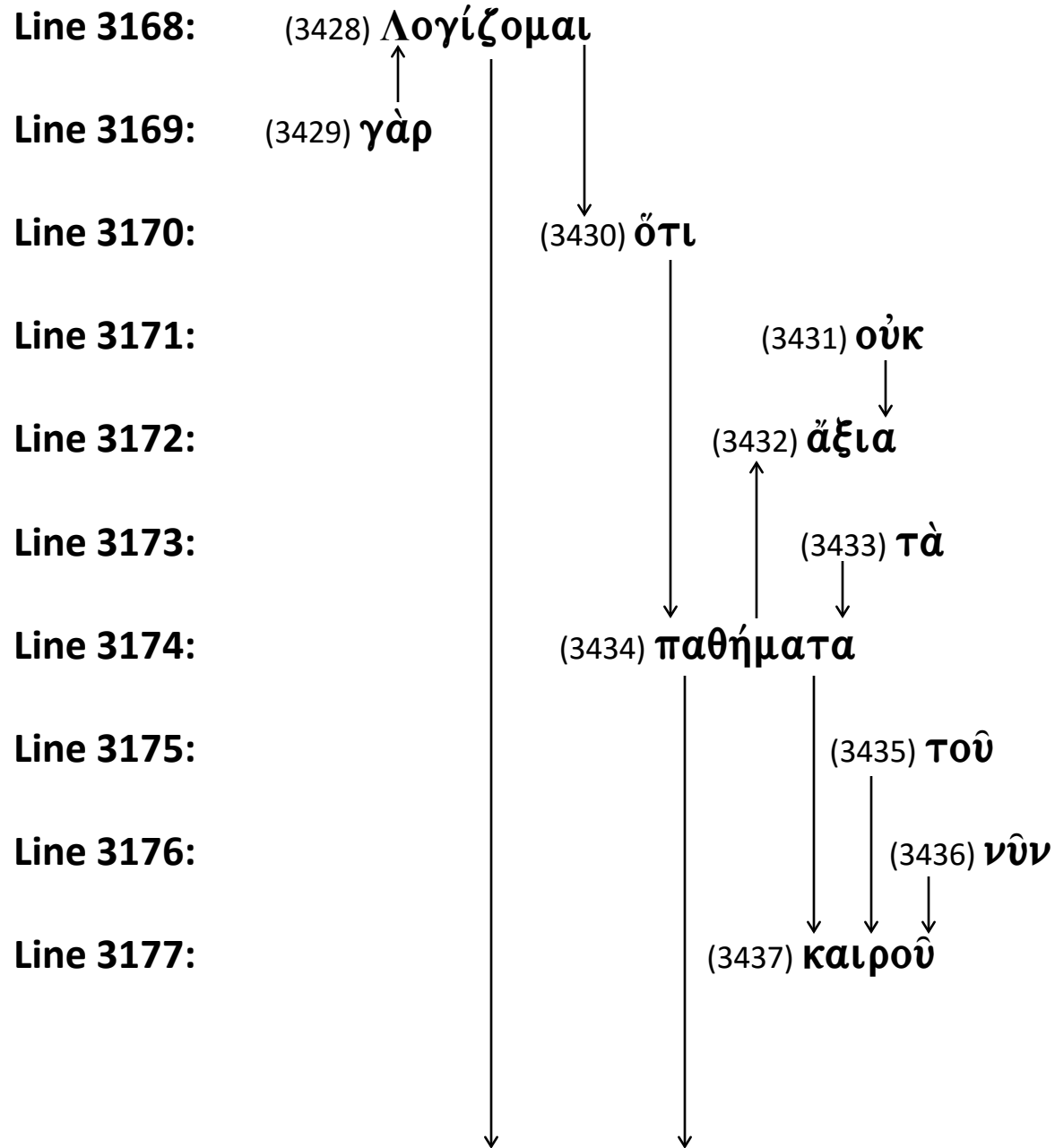
The Law of the Spirit of the Life in Christ Jesus.

Law Four

Romans 8:1-39 The Law of the Spirit of the Life in Christ Jesus

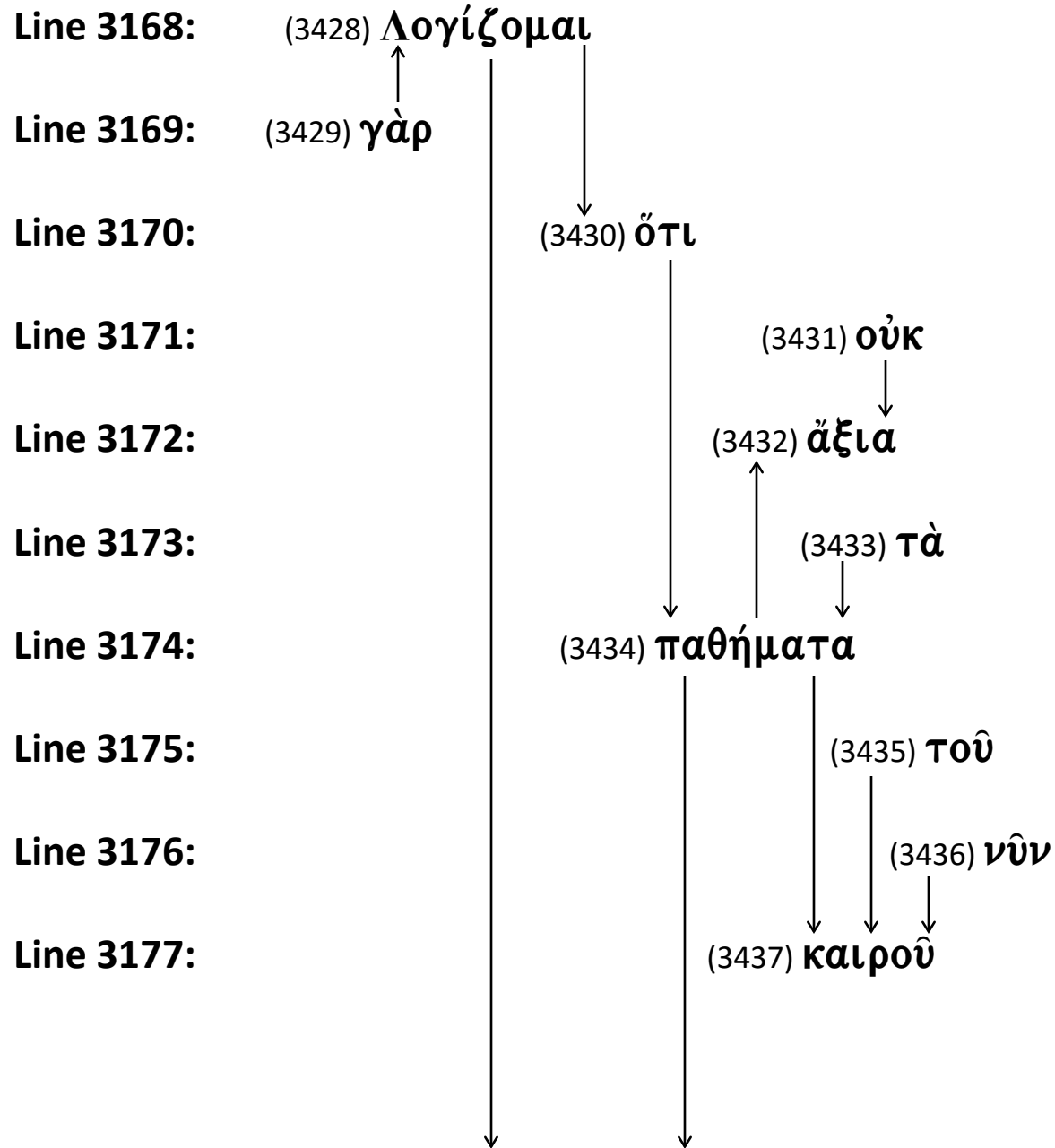
- Romans 8:2 1) Freed me from the Law of Sin and Death.**
- Romans 8:9 2) I was freed from the Law of Sin and Death when the Spirit of Christ came to permanently dwell in me.**
- Romans 8:15 3) When someone receives the Spirit of Christ, they receive the Spirit of adoption in which they cry, "Abba, Father."**

- Romans 8:14** 4) The ones who are sons of God, they are being led by the Spirit of God.
- Romans 8:16** 5) The Spirit of Christ Himself is testifying with our spirit that we are children of God.
- Romans 8:17** 6) Since we are children of God through the Spirit of adoption, we are inheritors of God, especially inheritors together of Christ.
- Romans 8:17** 7) Our inheritance together of Christ is to suffer together with Him, in order that one day we should be glorified together with Him.
