Verse 6: Statement

Now *it is* not such as that the Word of God has failed. For not all the ones of Israel are Israel.

- * Not children of the flesh are the remnant, but children of the promise
- * Based on promise given to Abraham in Genesis 18:10 and to Rebecca in Genesis 25:23

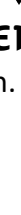
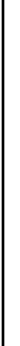

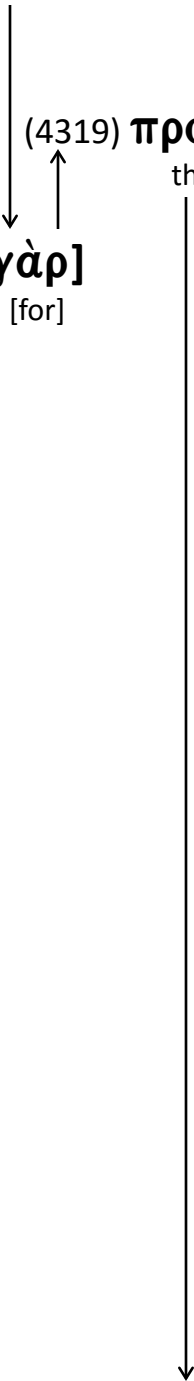
