THE GOSPEL OF MATTHEW

PHARISEE = "to separate"

A. strict, legalistic, religious sect

B. observed the letter of the law according to oral tradition called MISHNAH

- 1. they believed in resurrection of the dead
- 2. they believed in immortality of the soul
- 3. they believed in future judgment
- 4. they believed in the existence of supernatural beings

Matthew 5:31-32

- ³¹ It hath been said, Whosoever shall put away his wife, let him give her a writing of divorcement:
- ³² But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery.

Deuteronomy 24:1-4

¹When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give *it* in her hand, and send her out of his house.

² And when she is departed out of his house, she may go and be another man's *wife*.

Deuteronomy 24:1-4 (continued)

³ And *if* the latter husband hate her, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth *it* in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her *to be* his wife;

⁴ Her former husband, which sent her away, may not take her again to be his wife, after that she is defiled; for that *is* abomination before the LORD: and thou shalt not cause the land to sin, which the LORD thy God giveth thee *for* an inheritance.

Two Schools:

SHAMMAI = strict divorce only for sexual immorality

HILLEL divorce for any reason

Genesis 1:27
