1) All prophecies concerning the last days are based upon Daniel 9:24-27, which presents the 70th week of Daniel.

- 2) The 70th Week of Daniel is divided into four sections:
 - 1) Pains of birth: first 3 ½ years of the Tribulation.
 - 2) Pivotal point: the mid-point of the Tribulation.
 - 3) Perils of tribulation: the last 3 ½ years of the Great Tribulation.
 - 4) Promise of his coming: the Second Coming of Christ.

3) Mark 13

- The Circumstances Surrounding the Birth Pains: verses 5-13


- The Corruption of the Temple: verse 14
- The Circumstances of the Tribulation: verses 15-23
- The Coming of Christ: verses 24-27

- 4) End time prophecies are centered on the Jewish People.
- 5) Matthew took his outline of the 70th week of Daniel from Mark 13 and they both recorded the Olivet discourse.
- The misunderstanding of the prophecies of the last days is based upon combining Luke's account with Matthew's and Mark's account as if they are the same message

- Luke's version includes some of the same information given at a different time, and covering different stages of the 70th Week of Daniel.
 - 1. Luke 21:5-6 Jesus still in the Temple area
 - 2. Luke 21:7 records different questions
 When will these things be?
 What sign will there be when these
 things shall come to pass?
 - 3. Luke covers the first part of the pains of birth in Luke 21:8-11

 Luke 21:12 "before all of these things"
