Ganesaret is another name for the Sea of Galilee.

The Sea of Galilee is also called Tiberias in John 6:1  
and John 21:1.

The word Ganesaret comes from the Hebrew word,  
Kanar that means heart and is a heart shaped lake.

It is 13 miles long and 7 1/2 miles wide.

It's about 150 feet at it's deepest place.

It is a freshwater lake over 690 feet below sea level.

27 feet long and 7 1/2 feet wide
