<sup>6</sup> Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time: <sup>7</sup> Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

#### Matthew 10:34-36

- <sup>34</sup> Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword.

  <sup>35</sup> For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.
- <sup>36</sup> And a man's foes shall be they of his own household.

#### I Corinthians 7:29-35

- <sup>29</sup> But this I say, brethren, the time is short: it remaineth, that both they that have wives be as though they had none;
- <sup>30</sup> And they that weep, as though they wept not; and they that rejoice, as though they rejoiced not; and they that buy, as though they possessed not;
- <sup>31</sup> And they that use this world, as not abusing it: for the fashion of this world passeth away.

### I Corinthians 7:29-35 (continued)

<sup>32</sup> But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may please the Lord: 33 But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please his wife. <sup>34</sup> There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please her husband.

### I Corinthians 7:29-35 (continued)

<sup>35</sup> And this I speak for your own profit; not that I may cast a snare upon you, but for that which is comely, and that ye may attend upon the Lord without distraction.
