

II Corinthians 10:4-6

4) For the tools of our warfare *are* not fleshly, but powerful *with* God for the pulling down of strongholds;

5) pulling down reasonings and every high thing exalting itself against the knowledge of God and taking captive every thought into the obedience of Christ;

6) and having in readiness that we should avenge all disobedience, whenever your obedience should be fulfilled.

<u>LOGOS</u> = philosophers represented the thinker behind universe

<u>WAS</u> = continuous existence in the past

<u>MADE</u> = to create, to come into existence

John 1:1-18 = prologue

— verses 1-2 The Relationship of the Word to God

– verses 3-5 The Relationship of the Word to Creation

verses 6-9 Explanation: John the Baptist is not the light of the world.

verses 10-11 The Relationship of the Word to the World

verses 12-13 Explanation: The rejection of the Word.

verses 14-15 The Relationship of the Word to the Human (Flesh)

verses 16-17 Explanation: Receiving fulness of grace.
