John 17:20-26

Romans 8:26

Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

Romans 8:34

Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea, rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

John 10:17-18

17) Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again.

18) No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father.

John 12:27

Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say?
Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause
came I unto this hour.

John 14:10

Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, He doeth the works.

John 6:37

All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

John 6:39

And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which He hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

John 6:44

No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

Matthew 18:8

Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast *them* from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire.

Matthew 25:41

Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand,
"Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire,
prepared for the devil and his angels:"

Matthew 25:46

And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

John 14:6

Jesus saith unto him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me."

I John 5:20

And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know Him that is true, and we are in Him that is true, *even* in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

John 3:36

He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life:
and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life;
but the wrath of God abideth on him.

John 5:13

And he that was healed wist not who it was: for Jesus had conveyed himself away, a multitude being in that place.

John 19:30

When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, "It is finished:" and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Philippians 2:5-11

5) Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

6) Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

7) But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

8) And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

Philippians 2:5-11 (cont.)

9) Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

10) That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of *things* in heaven, and *things* in earth, and *things* under the earth;

11) And *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

John 6:39

And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which He hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

John 6:70

Jesus answered them, "Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?"

John 13:27

And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus, "That thou doest, do quickly."

Psalm 41:9

Psalm 109:4-13

I John 4:4

Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

I John 5:18

We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.

II Thessalonians 2:13

But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:

I Peter 1:2

Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.

I Thessalonians 4:4

That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;

I Corinthians 1:30

But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

Ephesians 2:14-16

14) For He is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition *between us*;

15) Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, *even the law of commandments contained* in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, so making peace;

16) And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

I Corinthians 12:12-13

12) Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all patience, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds.

13) For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except *it be* that I myself was not burdensome to you? forgive me this wrong.
