

Psalm 19:1-4

- 1) The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.
- 2) Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge.
- 3) *There is* no speech nor language, *where* there voice is not heard.
- 4) Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun.

John 1:9

That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.

- 13) For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- 14) How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

James 1:22-25

- 22) But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves.
- 23) For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass:
- 24) For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was.
- 25) But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed.

Galatians 1:8-9

- 8) But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.
- 9) As we said before, so say I now again, if any *man* preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

Galatians 1:11-12

- 11) But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man.
- 12) For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught *it*, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

Deuteronomy 7:25-26

Deuteronomy 10:15-16

15) Only the Lord had a delight in thy fathers to love them, and he chose their seed after them, *even* you above all people, as *it is* this day.

16) Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart, and be no more stiffnecked.

Deuteronomy 30:5-6

- 5) And the Lord thy God will bring thee into the land which thy fathers possessed, and thou shalt possess it; and he will do thee good, and multiply thee above thy fathers.
- 6) And the Lord thy God will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live.
