

I. About the Author

- Paul - his inscription is on all thirteen of his letters

II. To Whom It Was Written

- To the church in Ephesus.
- Ephesians is believed to be a circulation letter distributed throughout Asia. Many older manuscripts do not contain the words "in Ephesus" in verse 1.

III. The History of Ephesus

- Ephesus was the Roman capital of Asia.
- Ephesus was known for having one of the seven wonders of the world - the temple of Artemis (or Diana).
- Ephesus is believed to be evangelized by Priscilla and Aquila. (Acts 18:18-19)
- The church in Ephesus was later established by Paul during his third missionary journey. (Acts 19)
- Paul ministered there for three years.
- After Paul left, Timothy pastored the church for about 1 1/2 years.
- Paul wrote to Timothy in Ephesus to counter false teaching by two leaders in the church in Ephesus - Hymenaeus and Alexander. (I Timothy 1:3 and I Timothy 1:20)
- Thirty years later, Christ gave a message to Ephesus in Revelation 2:1-7.

IV. The Theme of Ephesians

- The believer's position in Christ.
- "in Christ" is the key phrase in Ephesians.

V. Date / Background

- Written around 63 A.D. while Paul was in prison in Rome. (Acts 28:16-31)
House arrest for two years. Ephesians is one of the prison letters. Others include Philippians, Colossians and Philemon.
