### The Place Where Jesus was Buried

#### Matthew 28:1-4

##### The Introduction to the Tomb

1 ¶Now after *the* sabbath, at the dawning toward *the* first of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary, to view the grave.

2 And, behold! A great earthquake happened! For after an angel of *the* Lord had descended from out of Heaven and after having come, he rolled away the stone away from the door and *was* sitting upon it.

3 And his appearance was as lightning and his clothing white as if snow.

4 And the ones keeping guard were shaken from the fear of him, and they became as if dead.

#### Matthew 28:5-8

##### The Interaction at the Tomb

5 and when the angel responded, he said to the women, “You yourselves do not fear, for I know that you are seeking Jesus, the One who has been crucified.

6 “He is not here, for He was raised, according as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord was lying.

7 “And after having gone quickly tell His disciples that He was raised from the dead. And behold, He is going before you into Galilee. There you will see Him. Behold, I told you.”

8 And after having gone out quickly from the tomb, with fear and great joy, they ran to report to His disciples.

#### **Philippians 3:7-9**

##### **The Transformation of Paul**

**7** But what things were gain to me, these things I have considered loss on account of Christ.

**8** But, yes, rather I am also considering all things to be loss on account of the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord, on account of whom I suffered loss of all things and consider *them to be refuse*, in order that I might gain Christ

**9** ¶ and should be found in Him; not having my own righteousness from out of Law, but *the righteousness* through faith of Christ, the righteousness of God upon the basis of faith,

#### **Philippians 3:10-12**

##### **The Motivation of Paul**

**10** to know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, while being conformed to His death,

**11** if somehow I may arrive at the resurrection from out of the dead.

**12** Not that I already received or I have already been perfected, but I am pursuing, if I also may take hold, upon which as I also was taken hold of by Christ Jesus.
