Matthew 28:1-4
The Circumstances

1) Now after *the* sabbath, at the dawning toward *the* first of *the* week, Mary the Magdalene and the other Mary came to view the tomb.

2) And, behold! A great earthquake happened! For *an* angel of *the* Lord had descended out of heaven and after he had come, he rolled away the stone from the door and was sitting upon it.

3) And the appearance of him was as lightning and his clothing white as if snow.

4) And the ones keeping guard were shaken from the fear of him, and they became as if dead.

Matthew 28:5-6
The Contents of the Tomb

5) And when the angel responded, he said to the women, You yourselves do not fear, for I know that you seek Jesus, the One who has been crucified.

6) He is not here, for He was raised, according as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord was lying.

The Command to the Women

7) And after going quickly tell His disciples that He was raised from the dead. And behold! He is going before you into Galilee. There you will see Him. Behold! I told you.

8) And having gone out quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, they ran to report to His disciples.

The Personal Appearance of Jesus

The Confrontation with Jesus

9) And as they were going to report to His disciples, also behold, Jesus met them, saying, Rejoice! And the ones having come near, took hold of His feet and worshiped Him.

10) Then Jesus says to them, Do not fear. Go report to My brothers in order that they might go into Galilee, and there they will see Me.

I Peter 1:1-5

1) Peter, *an* apostle of Jesus Christ, to *the* elect strangers of *the* Diaspora of Pontus, of Galatia, of Cappadocia, of Asia, and of Bithynia,

2) according to the foreknowledge of God *the* Father, in sanctification of *the* Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of *the* blood of Jesus Christ: May grace and peace be multiplied to you.

3) Blessed *is* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the one according to His great mercy has regenerated us into *a* living hope through *the* resurrection of Jesus Christ from out of *the* dead,

4) into an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and unfading, having been kept in heaven for you,

5) the ones who are being guarded in *the* power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time;

Ephesians 2:1-6

- 1) and you while being dead *in* trespasses and sins,**
- 2) in which you once walked according to the age of this world, according to the ruler of the authority of the air, of the spirit now working in the sons of the disobedience,**
- 3) among whom also we all ourselves had lifestyles once in the lusts of our flesh, *by* doing the things willed of the flesh and of the thoughts, and we were *by* nature children of wrath, as even the rest.**
- 4) But God, being rich in mercy, on account of His great love *with* which He loved us,**
- 5) and we being dead in trespasses, *He* made us alive together with Christ; *by* grace you are having been saved,**
- 6) and *He* raised *us* up together and seated *us* together in the spirit realm in Christ Jesus,**

Ephesians 1:15-20

15) On account of this I also, after having heard with respect to your faith in the Lord Jesus, and the love toward all the saints,

16) I do not cease giving thanks on behalf of you, *by* making mention of you upon the occasion of my prayers;

17) In order that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and revelation in full-knowledge of him:

18) The eyes of your mind having been enlightened; for you to know what is the hope of his calling, and what *is* the wealth of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

19) And what *is* the surpassing greatness of his power toward us, the ones believing, according to the energy of the grip of His strength,

20) Which he energized in Christ, having raised him from out of the dead, and sat *him* in his right in the spirit realm,
